Before they crossed the Jordan River to enter the Promised Land after wandering in the wilderness for forty years, God's people promised to remember their history and teach their descendants what God had done for them. They also took 12 large stones from the Jordan River and built a monument to help them remember.

Our forefathers left names on places and movements so that we would remember where we came from and who helped us get where we are today. We are Christians, because we worship Jesus, the Christ. We belong to Great Kills Moravian Church.

What are Kills? What's a Moravian? Down the street and around the corner from our church are two other Christian churches—the Church of St. Clare, a Roman Catholic Church; and Christ Lutheran Church—with whom we sometimes share ecumenical worship services. Who was St. Clare? Whom do Lutherans remember? Answers to this quiz are at the end of the newsletter.

The Moravian Church honors John Hus each year. In 1415 Hus, was burned at the stake for speaking against some practices of the Catholic Church of Bohemia. Hus, considered by many to be the first Protestant reformer, influenced Martin Luther who wrote and protested a century later. Indeed, New York metro churches will commemorate his martyrdom at John Hus Moravian Church in Brooklyn on July 14. We are invited and urged to attend.

During times when Christians disagree about what Jesus wants us to do, remember that Jesus said we are to love God and love one another. Moravians affirm, "in essentials unity; in non- essentials liberty, in all things love."
