You are invited to a baptism on September 8.

Baptism is an outward sign of an inward grace. Christians are baptized into Jesus' death. We believe that through the power of the Holy Spirit, we will be raised like him from death into new life. Most Christians acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins. If you were baptized as an infant, by a Roman Catholic priest, that's your one baptism. If you were completely immersed in a pool of water by an American Baptist, that's your one baptism. If water was poured or sprinkled on your head by an Episcopalian, a Methodist, or a Moravian minister that's your one baptism. In some traditions, babies are baptized. In others, a person has to be old enough to know what he's doing before being baptized. Some people choose to be baptized as adults. Nevertheless, there is one baptism.

Many families choose to share their joy with their church families when they bring their little ones to be baptized. After all, Matthew 19:14 records Jesus saying, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." We are delighted as a church to share our faith in God's grace with children and their parents.

Baptism is one of two sacraments that Protestant Christians observe. The other is holy communion. On Sunday, September 1, we will celebrate communion.

Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River by his cousin, John the Baptizer, shortly before he began his ministry. After his resurrection he told his disciples to go to all nations and baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

We want to offer a confirmation class for children who want to learn more about how their Christian faith affirms the new covenant God has made with people of faith. If you are interested, please speak with the pastor or call the church office.
