On December first there will be some new things in the sanctuary. The pulpit cloths, called paraments, that were green just last week will be purple through Advent, the four weeks before Christmas. White ones will replace them from Christmas through Epiphany on January 6. The Advent Wreath will be placed beside the pulpit with five candles—three purple, one pink, and one white. Each Sunday in Advent a new candle will be lit. First, purple for hope; second, purple for peace; third pink for joy; fourth purple for love. The white Christ candle in the center will be lit on Christmas Eve.

Familiar things will be in front of the church too. Figures representing Mary and Joseph, and the friendly beasts will wait beside an empty manger for the new baby to arrive. Overhead, the Moravian Star leads the way.

A new church year begins each Advent. The Revised Common Lectionary that the Moravian Church and other Christian churches and denominations follow is divided into three years: A, B, and C. Each year emphasizes readings from a different synoptic gospel: year A is Matthew, year B Mark, and Year C Luke. Gospel readings from now through next Advent will come mostly from Luke. Readings from John don't get their own year in the cycle but are included in all three years at appropriate times.

Advent is a season of anticipation. Christmas is coming. Christ, the Light of the World, is coming. Christ will come again. We live in perilous times. Many of us are apprehensive about changes in our government, about wars and rumors of wars. Mankind has always lived this way. Still we remember what the angels said to the shepherds when they announced the birth of Jesus, "Do not be afraid." Remember, the Moravian emblem declares, "Our Lamb has conquered, let us follow him."

An Advent Season Gift for Moravian Open Door Each Advent season we are reminded of the family long ago who were homeless, had no room at the inn, and not even a crib for their expected infant. Yet they were provided for. Moravian Open Door (MOD) is a Moravian ministry in New York City that provides a safe, clean, temporary home for homeless men and women. Currently we have 34 residents whose ages range from 53 to 91 years. While the facility (called Moravian House) provides accommodation in single and double rooms, the staff provides supportive services to rebuild lives and help residents move to affordable permanent housing.

MOD receives no government funding at all. Donations from individuals, congregations, and other private sources must cover the rest of operating expenses. Northern Province Racial Justice Team Advent Series

The Moravian Church Northern Province Racial Justice Team is pleased to present its New Way of Being Advent Series for 2024. This year's theme is, "The Doctrine of Discovery: What It Is and Why It Matters." There will be three one-hour sessions on December 4, 11, and 18 at 7:30pm to 8:30pm ET. All sessions will be on Zoom. As we look at our brothers and sisters in other countries. We acknowledge the need of Bishop John E. Knight Nursing Home, a Moravian facility in Antigua seeking adult diapers, wipes, incontinence pads and similar items. Bring them to the church (financial donations are also welcome.) United Moravian Church is preparing a shipment for Antigua.

The Provincial Elders' Conference of the Moravian Church Northern Province recently endorsed Christians Against Christian Nationalism. The Moravian Church Northern Province (MCNP) rejects Christian nationalism as a distortion of the gospel of Jesus Christ; as supporting the sins and systems of racism and white supremacy; and as a threat to democracy.

The Provincial Elders' Conference Northern Province has endorsed the National Council of Churches plea to help fight to protect the vital work of non-profit organizations. While the title of the 'Stop Terror-Financing and Tax Penalties on American Hostages Act' (HR 9495) may seem harmless, the bill includes provisions that could jeopardize the tax-exempt status of many secular and faith-based non-profit organizations that provide essential services such as humanitarian aid, education, healthcare, and advocacy for marginalized communities. These provisions introduce sweeping measures that target groups based on vague or overly broad criteria. Contact your Congressional representative to express your view. The church office has more information.

New York State has a home energy assistance program to help people who desperately need help paying for heating fuel, repairing a boiler, or buying a boiler. If you think you qualify for assistance or know someone who does, the church office can direct you to information.


