It's Spring. Daffodils are blooming. Soon the cherry trees and magnolias will be out. Canada geese are crossing Cleveland Avenue and strolling through the church parking lot. The vernal equinox, the time each spring when day and night are the same length, has passed. The full moon is April 12. And the first Sunday, after the first full moon, after the vernal equinox, is Easter—April 20 this year.

Easter is THE Christian holy day. We are Easter people. We proclaim Jesus Christ as God's son risen from the dead for our salvation. As Paul explained in 1 Corinthians 15:17, "If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins."

At his last meal with his closest friends, Jesus told them to remember him. Remember how they shared bread and wine at the Passover Seder. Recall that Passover is when God's people remember that they were slaves in Egypt and how God rescued them.

After all these centuries, Christians still gather to remember our Savior. We worship together every Sunday at 11:00, unless we can't make it. Then we Zoom in. We share communion on the first Sunday of each month. If you want communion cups delivered to your home, call the church office: 718-317-7788.

This month we have additional days and times to get together to remember Jesus. Holy Week begins Sunday, April 13 with the children reenacting Jesus's entry into Jerusalem when children welcomed him by waving palm branches.

Monday, April 14; Tuesday, April 15; and Wednesday April 16; we will share Holy Week Readings at 7:00pm via Zoom only. Click on the worship link on our greatkillsmoravian.org website to join.

Maundy Thursday, April 17, at 7:00pm we will serve the Last Supper in the upper room of Fellowship Hall. Tables will be arranged as depicted in Michelangelo's painting. Zoom will be available.

Good Friday, April 18, we will worship in person at 7:00pm in the sanctuary with a Tenebrae service. Tenebrae is an ancient worship practice where light is gradually removed from the sanctuary leaving shadows. Zoom will again be available.

On Easter, the joyful Day of Resurrection, we will celebrate together in person and on Zoom at 11:00am. We are Easter people. Christ is risen. Christ is risen indeed. Hallelujah!
